**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**BBQ RIB COOK-OFF SCHEDULE:**

8:00am	Check in/ site set up
9:30am	Cook's meeting/Meat Inspection
10:00am	Cooking begin
2:00pm	Cooking ends
2:15pm	Turn in time
2:30pm	Judging begins
7:00pm	Winners Announced

**JUDGING CRITERIA:**

1. Pork Spare Ribs only will be judged.
2. Entries will be judged by a panel of 5 judges.
3. The scoring system is 5 (excellent) to 1 (bad).
4. Scores will be based on:

**I. APPERANCE**

**II. TENDERNESS**

**III. TASTE**

5. The team with the highest overall number will be awarded 1st place, 2nd place and 3rd place will be awarded by the second and third highest score, respectively.
6. A team may consist of one (1) chief cook and as many four (4) assistants to the chief cooks.
7. Cooking may begin immediately following the cooks meeting.
8. Cooking teams must provide their own pork spare ribs to be cooked during the competition.
9. Spare ribs must be cooked and seasoned on site within the confines of your team's assigned cooking space.
10. Spare ribs may be seasoned, sauced or not, and cooked in a manner you feel will deliver a competitive product in the time allowed.



11. Each team will place 5 individually cut ribs in your “turn-in” box. The “turn-in” box will be provided by event staff. No marking, bending tabs, or any identifying marks of any kind are permitted on or in the “turn-in” boxes or they will be disqualified.
12. No marking or sculpting of the meat or “turn-in” box will be tolerated. No garnish, side sauce containers or any other foreign objects such as foil, toothpicks or skewers are allowed in the “turn-in” box. Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification.
13. **After the BBQ Cook-Off concludes; each team will be able to sell their BBQ and sides to the public. Only items prepared on a BBQ Grill will be allowed to sale.**

**SET-UP | REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Each team is to provide a grill/cooker that will be used exclusively by that team. Wood, charcoal, gas/propane, and smoker type barbeques are allowed. Electric ovens or solar ovens are not allowed. Contestants may not dig pits, and fires are not allowed on the ground.
2. A 20' x 20' space will be assigned to each team.
3. Each cook team is responsible to provide ALL of their own supplies; pork spare ribs, including pop up tents, tables, chairs, utensils, ingredients, supplies and safety wash station.
4. Electricity is not provided for any reason, and generators are not allowed.
5. No ice or water will be provided.
6. Safe food handling guidelines must be followed.

**CLEANLINESS | SAFETY RULES:**

1. Each Cook-Team is required to have a fire extinguisher in their booth.
2. Each Cook-Team is required to have a Harris County Food Permit.
3. Cleanliness of the cooks, assistant cooks and work space is required.
4. Shirt and shoes must be worn.
5. No use of tobacco products while handling the meat.
6. **Booth space must be left clean; otherwise you will be charged \$200.**
